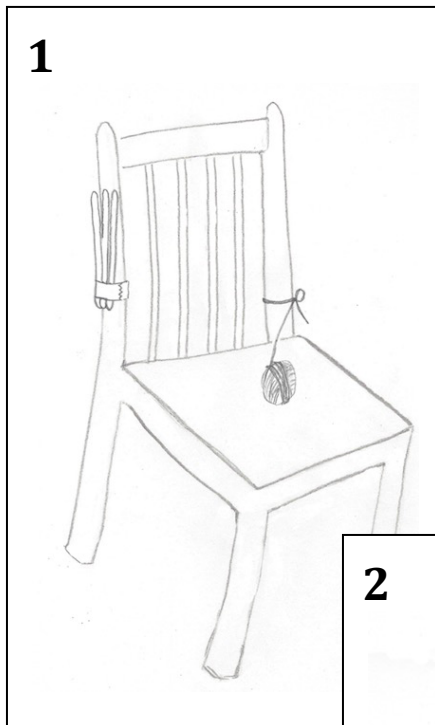
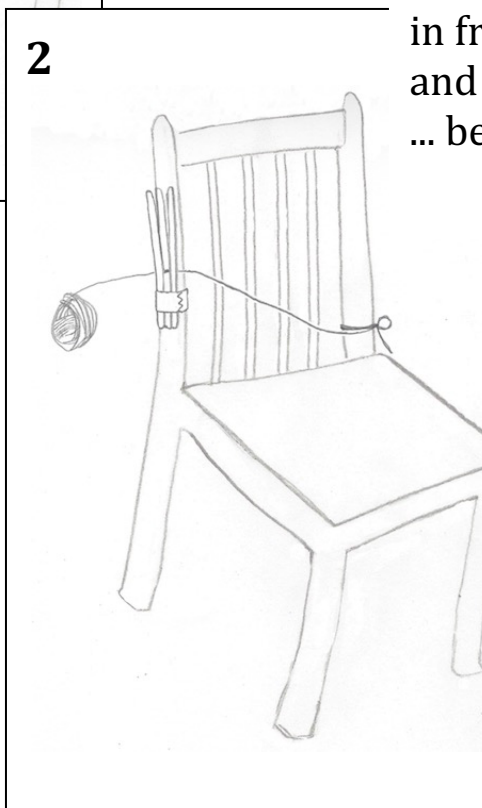


Set up a fingerweaving project

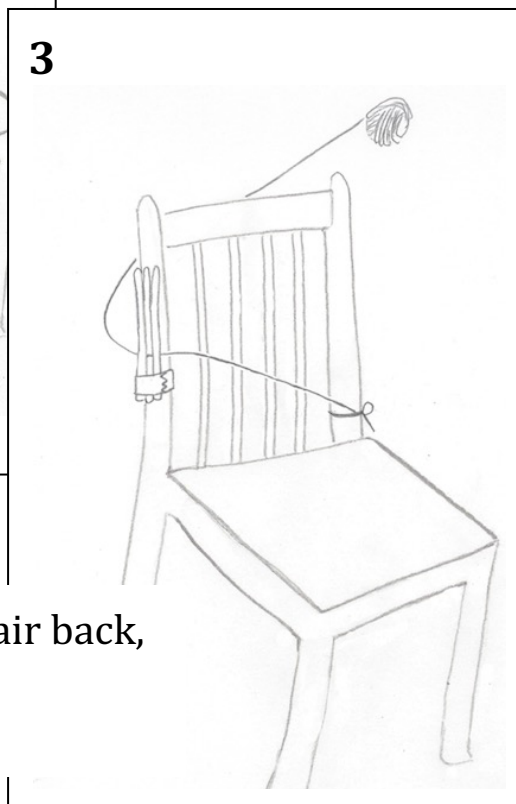


1. Tape three sticks together.
Tape them to the left side of the chair

Attach the yarn to the right side of the chair.

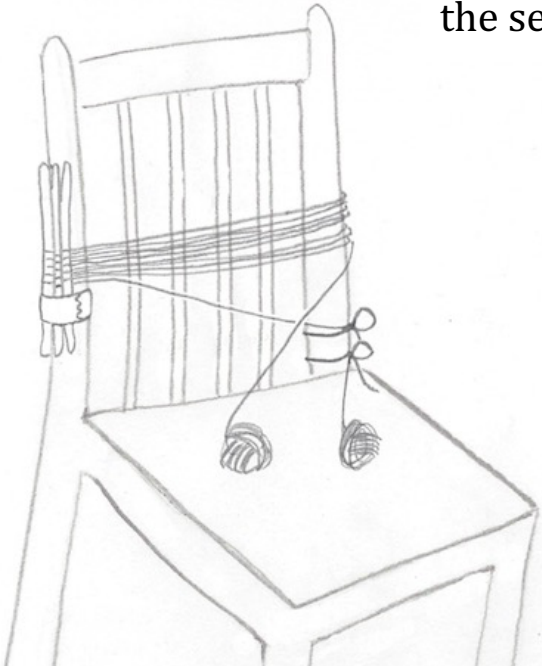


2. Take the yarn across
in front of the chairback
and "weave" it through the 3 sticks
... behind, in front, behind



3, Take the yarn behind the chair back,
and around

4. Wind the yarn around the chair back and "weave" through the 3 sticks: the first time was behind-infront-behind the second time will be infront-behind-infront.

When you have sufficient threads of that color, set the ball on the chairseat and attach the next color of yarn.

Attach the 2nd color on the same side of the chair where you attached the 1st color of yarn.

5. When you are ready to cut, remember to tape the top of the 3 sticks together before you cut.

Gather three groups of threads

1 the beginnings

2 the middles

3 the ends

(what goes to the balls of yarn)

Cut through all three groups, leaving sufficient room to tie a knot.
